Week beginning: 17th September 2018



Literacy

We will be learning the story 'The Noisy House'. Children will work on being able to tell the story in sequence, writing sentences and speech bubbles. We will work on supported writing, where ideas will be modelled and children can see how to break down longer words into the sounds heard. Children will work on writing simple sentences with a focus on applying their phonics skills, handwriting, leaving finger spaces in between words and using capital letters and full stops in the correct places. We will continue to work on children developing their handwriting to ensure letters are formed correctly.

Maths

Children will be developing their skills in following instructions and working independently when they work in their individual maths workbooks. Our focus this week is learning Number Bonds (pairs or numbers that make the same total). Children will explore using number bond diagram to show number bonds and will use a Ten Frame to explore finding different ways of making ten.

Topic

In our work in Art, children will be developing their skills in sketching to draw a self-portrait. Children will be encouraged to use detail and we will be using the marks made last week to create different effects. In Music, children will continue to learn our rap 'Hey You!' and will learn how to find the pulse and recreate rhythms. Our History session will involve us looking at similarities and differences between homes and we will begin to see how newer houses often have plastic framed windows and doors.

P.E

On a Monday, children will have PE with Mrs Hall and will be developing their skills in Games. On a Friday, we will be working on Gymnastics and we will continue to work on exploring ways of travelling and performing basic gymnastic actions over mats.
