Week Beginning: 3rd December 2018

English – This week the children will be focusing on spelling, punctuation and grammar. The children have been recapping on what they have learnt throughout the year so far. Spellings this week are focused on the spelling rule – The /u/ sound spelt ou. Spelling test will be on Friday.

Maths – During this week in maths the children will continue with multiplication and division. During this chapter the children will learn the different family facts and apply their learning to word problems. Times tables will be very important in this chapter so please make sure the children are learning at home as well as at school. The children will also be assessed on their times tables. The times tables test focus is 8.

Topic - This week in Geography the children will be discussing what they have learnt and enjoyed from this topic. The children will also prepare for some stone Age cooking the following week.

INFORMATION
