
Week beginning: 28th January 2019

Literacy

This week in National Storytelling Week so we will be looking at a range of stories over the week. We will begin with Not Now Bernard (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6ptST-5w6tU) and children will design and describe their own monster. We will introduce 'adjectives' describing words to write sentences about out monsters. Children will also learn about story structure and will be planning their own story based on their own choices.

Maths

We will be looking at measurements this week. Children will continue to learn about using the language long/longer/longest and short/shorter/shortest when measuring length. We will be using hands and feet to measure. Children will then learn how to use a ruler to accurately measure length using centimetres. Here is an example of one our problems to solve:



Topic

In Art, we will be working on recreating drawings of buildings based on Lowry's work. Children will be learning about line, shape and perspective.

In History, children will be exploring drama through acting as Florence or soldiers.

P.E

On a Monday, children will have PE with Rising Stars sports coach and will be developing their skills in Games. On a Friday, we will be working on Gymnastics and we will continue to work on exploring ways of travelling and performing basic gymnastic actions over mats. Children will develop their awareness of shapes they can make with their body.
