Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will be practising getting ourselves undressed and dressed for PE.
- We will be focusing on this terms school value.
- We will be working towards our own personal targets
- We will be looking at our work and talk about our own achievements.
- We will be ensuring we follow the rules of basic hygiene, remembering to wash our hands after the toilet and before we eat.
- We will be joining in with different activities and developing our skills to take turns.

Physical Development

- We will continue to develop our hand writing and learn to sit our writing correctly on the line.

Communication and Language

- We will be practising following instructions given by others.
- Using the Easi phones we will be practising making and receiving calls.
- We will be developing our skills to listen to one another and respond to questions.
- We will be asking questions to find out about things that interest us.
- We will be developing our knowledge of vocabulary and applying it in our learning.

Literacy

- This week we will be focusing on St Georges Day.
- We will be sequencing and retelling events in order.
- We will be writing our own wanted dragon posters.
- We will be using our taught phonics to write complete sentences linked to our learning.
- We will be continuing with our RWI sessions (phonics)

Maths

- We will be counting on and back on a number line.
- We will be solving number problems by finding out how many different ways we can make 10 then 20. E.g. 6+4, 7+3, 2+8
- We will be creating our own tally charts and discussing our findings. E.g. what was the most and least popular?
- We will be creating our own flying dragons and measuring the distance in which they fly.

Understanding the world

- We using Easi phones & Beebots in our learning.
- We will be using construction and loose parts to create our own castles.
- We will be learning about the English celebration of St George's day and comparing them to other celebrations and beliefs.

Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be using sketching pencils to draw observational drawings of castles.
- We will be using recycled materials to create our own castles and dragons.
- We will be designing and making our own shields out of card.
