SCHOOL POLICY FOR BAD WEATHER CLOSURE

As we approach the bad weather we would like to inform you of our procedures for closing the school in the event of serious weather.

Although the policy for all schools is to remain open whenever possible, the school has a duty to care for the safety of children and staff. The head teacher, in consultation with the school Governors, may decide to close the school in extreme weather if the weather conditions are so severe that it is dangerous for children and staff to travel safely to, or from, school.

Once the decision has been made to either close the school or delay opening you will be notified via SMS text. It is therefore important that we have your correct mobile telephone number. Our school website www.thornhill-primary.co.uk will also be updated accordingly. **PLEASE DO NOT TELEPHONE THE SCHOOL TO SEE IF WE ARE OPEN**.

The school will use the Central Bedfordshire SOS service which has a direct link to the local radio stations so announcements will be made on the radio.

As a parent you can also register to receive SOS messages from Central Bedfordshire. Please see below how to register:

Using SOS to register to receive alerts

In order to receive an update on the school's open status, you need to register on Central Bedfordshire Council's SOS system:

CLOSURE DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

If the weather deteriorates significantly during the day, the school may decide to close early to allow children and staff to return home safely. Parents and carers will be contacted accordingly. **No child will be released early from school until a parent or carer has collected him or her.**
