

MATHS

Children will begin the Year 1 Maths No Problem scheme. We will be using ten frames to represent numbers. They will then be writing numbers using both numerals and words. Children will explore working on ordering and comparing numbers.

We will move onto Chapter 2, we will work on knowing number bonds to 10 (knowing which pairs of numbers make 10, e.g, 3+7, 2+8 etc). Children will need to know these number facts by heart.

HISTORY

Children will be learning about their own history and will consider how they have changed since being a baby. We will look at houses and homes and compare how people's houses and lives have changed from in the past to the modern day.



COMMUNITY LINKS

We will be going on a walk in the local area to look at different houses, thinking about their features and how they are made.

RE

Our topic for RE over the next term is 'Special Books'. Children will be thinking about what book/s are special to them, and why.

They will also begin to learn about the religious books that are special to Christian, Muslim and Jewish people.

SCIENCE

We will become scientists and work on our knowledge and understanding of the 5 senses. Children will partake in different investigations involving sight, smell, hearing, touch and taste.

We will be focusing on hearing all sounds in longer words including sounds that are made by two letters (oi, ou, th etc) and three letters (ear, air, ure). Much of our work will be on sentence construction, with opportunities for children to add their ideas into longer sentences.
