

Literacy

This half term the children will be looking at the book 'Salty Dogs' by Matty Long. They will be learning how to use alliteration in their writing. Some children will be learning about personal pronouns and recapping how to use question marks and explanation marks. Some children will be learning about homophones and how to use possessive apostrophes.

They will use these key skills to create a biography, newspaper report and play script.

The children will be continuing to use Nessler this half term to help them develop their reading and spelling skills. We will also be using a handwriting intervention called 'Speed up handwriting' which focuses on hand control.

Personal hygiene

This half term we will be making:

- Burgers

Each week we will be focusing on an aspect of personal hygiene. We will cover healthy diets, showering and nail hygiene. We will be sequencing pictures and creating posters.

Maths

Money

The children will be recognising coins and notes and identifying the value of each one. They will be counting money in 2s, 5s and 10s. They will be recognising which coins they can use to represent a specific amount. They will be adding money together and working out change.

Shape

The children will be recognising 2D and 3D shapes. They will be making patterns and grouping shapes using different criteria. They will be identifying and counting vertices, faces and edges. They will be constructing nets as well as identifying lines of symmetry in shapes.

Fractions

The children will be identifying shapes that have been split into 2 and 4 equal parts. They will be grouping objects into halves and quarters and recognising half and quarter of a number. They will name fractions and begin to recognise equivalent fractions.

They will focus on halves, thirds and quarters.
