THE SPAG PAPER - 45 mins

(Spelling, punctuation & grammar)

(Monday 14th May) 50 MARKS

This paper will test your child's knowledge of spelling rules and all possible punctuation and English grammar structures. The format of questions to answer will include: tick boxes, multiple choice, missing words and partially complete sentences.

Please note: the spelling test is administered separately by the teacher.

THE READING PAPER - 1 hour

(Tuesday 15th May) - 50 MARKS

Approximately 40 questions with 1, 2 & 3 marks available for each.

This paper will test your child's ability to comprehend what they have read. They will use skills in: 'fact retrieval', recognising clues, inference, summarising and determine fact from opinion. They will also comment on the structure of texts, word choices and the impact on the reader.

There will be 3 individual, unrelated texts in different genres with questions to go with each. Text types could be: non-fiction, poetry, fictional stories, reports etc. It is advised that your child use 20 minutes per text to read and answer the questions.

THE MATHS PAPERS

PAPER 1 - ARITHMETIC - 30 mins (Wednesday 16th May) - 40 MARKS

Approximately 36 questions with 1 - 2 marks available for each

This paper will test your child in their knowledge of 'pure maths' using the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

PAPER 2 - REASONING - 40 mins (Wednesday 16th May) - 35 MARKS

PAPER 3 - REASONING - 40 mins (Thursday 17th May) - 35 MARKS

Approximately 2 questions with 1, 2 and 3 marks available for each.

These papers will test your child in reasoning and problem solving across various forms of math, which will include: number, geometry, fractions, statistics, measures, the 4 operations and algebra.

It is very important that your child eats and sleeps well during the run-up to SATs, as they will be working very hard. Please encourage your child to do as much revision and practice at home, as well as complete additional tasks set.
