Week beginning Monday 24th September 2018

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will be practising getting ourselves undressed and dressed for PE.
- We will be focusing on this terms school value "Peace"
- We will be ensuring we follow the rules of basic hygiene, remembering to wash our hands after the toilet and before we eat.
- We will be joining in with different activities and developing our skills to take turns.
- We will be discussing the feeling people might have when performing at a circus and relating them to our own.

Physical Development

- We will develop our fine motor skills through the use of tweezers, threading, cutting etc. This will help to develop our pencil grip.
- We will be using larger equipment such as balls, skipping ropes and hoops to develop our gross motor.
- In PE we will be practicing our balancing skills and developing our coordination through the use of balls

Communication and Language

- We will be practising following instructions given by classroom adults.
- Using the Easi phones we will be practising making and receiving calls.

Literacy

- We will be hearing and identifying the first sound in words and then moving onto 3 letter words such as cat, dog, and hat.
- We will be practising our letter formation through daily practise of writing our names as well as daily handwriting practise.
- We will be starting our RWI sessions (phonics) – focusing on the sounds d,t,i,n,p– recognising the sounds as well as recording it using cursive formation. *d t i n p*

Maths

- We will be counting objects to 5 then 10, extending to 20 when ready.
- We will be matching quantity to numeral. For example matching 4 objects to the number 4.
- We will be creating our own repeating patterns using stamps.
- We will be continuing to write our numbers confidently to 10 using the correct number formation.

Understanding the world

- Using our 2simple art program, we will create our own pictures.
- We using Easi phones & Beebots in our learning.
- We will be playing simple computer software to practise our number and sound recognition.
- We will be looking at what part of the world circus animals originally come from using globes and maps.

- We will be painting, finding out what colours we can make by mixing.
- We will be using recycled materials to create objects.
- We will be using percussion instruments to explore sound and rhythm.
- We will be finding the pulse in the music we listen to.
- We will be drawing ourselves.
- We will be using shapes and different materials to create our own clown faces.
