Week beginning Monday 14th January

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will be practising getting ourselves undressed and dressed for PE.
- We will be focusing on this terms school value 'hope'.
- We will be setting our own personal targets for what we hope to achieve in Bobcats.
- We will be ensuring we follow the rules of basic hygiene, remembering to wash our hands after the toilet and before we eat.
- We will be joining in with different activities and developing our skills to take turns.
- We will be encouraged to work with others to complete physical challenges.

Physical Development

- We will develop our fine motor skills through the use of tweezers, threading, cutting etc. This will help to develop our pencil grip.
- We will be using larger equipment such as balls, skipping ropes and hoops to develop our gross motor.
- In PE we will be exploring different ways of traveling on and off apparatus.

Communication and Language

- We will be practising following instructions given by classroom adults.
- Using the Easi phones we will be practising making and receiving calls.
- We will be developing our skills to listen to one another and respond to questions.
- We will be asking questions to find out about things that interest us.
- We will be developing our knowledge of vocabulary and applying it in our learning.

Literacy

- This week we are having a 'Dragon Bake off!'
- We will be creating and recording our own invitations.
- We will be writing our own shopping lists for our ingredients.
- We will be practising our letter formation through daily practise of writing our names as well as daily handwriting practise linked to our previously taught sounds.
- We will be continuing with our RWI sessions (phonics)

Maths

- We will be exploring 3D shapes, learning their names and identify 3D shapes in our everyday environment. E.g. a glue stick is a cylinder.
- We will be finding one more than by having an amount and adding one to find our answer.
- We will be continuing to write our numbers confidently to 10 using the correct number formation, extending to 20 when ready.
