Week beginning Monday 25th February

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will be practising getting ourselves undressed and dressed for PE.
- We will be focusing on this term's school value 'Friendship'.
- We will be reviewing our own personal targets and setting new ones.
- We will be looking at our work and talk about our own achievements.
- We will be ensuring we follow the rules of basic hygiene, remembering to wash our hands after the toilet and before we eat.
- We will be joining in with different activities and developing our skills to take turns.
- We will be encouraged to work with others to complete physical challenges.
- **Physical Development**
- We will develop our fine motor skills through the use of tweezers, threading, cutting etc. This will help to develop our pencil grip.
- We will be using larger equipment such as balls, skipping ropes and hoops to develop our gross motor.
- In PE we will be exploring ball skills. Using different balls, focusing on throwing, catching and dribbling.

Communication and Language

- We will be practising following instructions given by classroom adults.
- Using the Easi phones we will be practising making and receiving calls.
- We will be developing our skills to listen to one another and respond to questions.
- We will be asking questions to find out about things that interest us.
- We will be developing our knowledge of vocabulary and applying it in our learning.

Literacy

- This week we will be focusing on the Jungle.
- We will be writing our words and sentences using our taught sounds.
- We will be also using our sounds to read words and to draw pictures to match those words to show our understanding.
- We will be practising our letter formation through daily practise of writing our names as well as daily handwriting practise linked to our previously taught sounds using the cursive formation.
- We will be continuing with our RWI sessions (phonics)

Maths

- We will be finding 'half' by sharing a given amount onto two plates one at a time. E.g. 'One for you, one for me'.
- We will be finding half of a shape by recognising that we need to cut it into 2 equal parts.
- We will be sorting, ordering and measuring objects of different, size, colour, length and capacity.

Understanding the world

- Using our 2simple art program, we will create our own pictures.
- We using Easi phones & Beebots in our learning.
- We will be solving challenges using loose parts such as wood, cable reels and tubes.
- We will be learning about the Jungle and who lives there.
- We will be comparing the environment of the Jungle to our own.
- We identifying what clothes we need to pack to travel to the Jungle
- We will be solving science experiments including making our own volcanoes.

Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be creating our own environments for our chosen animals to live their – e.g. Jungle scene for a tiger.
- We will be using pastels to create our own skin patterns of different types of wild animals.
- We will be practising our sketching skills through observational drawings, focusing on line and shape.
- We will be finding the pulse in the music we listen to and using the glockenspiels.
- We will be using our imaginations to create our own narrative using small world and puppets.
