Literacy

This week the children will be working on creating their own version of the story of Where the Wild Things Are using their own wild thing character. The children will create a story mountain to plan their story which will then help them to write their story in sentences. They will use adjectives to describe the feelings of the main characters and this week learn more about verbs when writing about the actions of the wild things in their story. Children will also be using exciting story language.


The children will be getting their new spellings on Monday to learn at home and will be tested on Friday.

Maths

This week children will continue their work on place value where children will use what they have learnt about tens and units and the value of each digit to help them to make different number bonds. Please support them at home with this. Children will also look at patterns within sequences of numbers and explain how the digits are changing e.g. increasing, decreasing.

Topic

In Art this week the children will be mixing paints to make autumn colours. Children will learn about tinting (where you add black each time to make a colour darker) and shading (where white is added to make a colour lighter). In Geography children will be learning about the U.K. and its capital city. They will learn about the U.K.'s four countries using atlases to locate them.

P.E

In P.E this week children will be using apparatus to help them learn more about how they use their bodies to travel in different ways and how they can use different body parts to balance.

Information

Children will be tested on their spellings and times tables every Friday. Please make sure you are supporting your children with learning these at home. 😊

Homework

Homework will be linked with literacy, reading comprehension and Maths and some weeks children will receive some topic based homework. Homework will be handed out on a **Friday** and **must** be returned to school by the following **Tuesday** in order to be marked. **Children who do not complete their homework on time will complete it in a lunchtime detention on Wednesday.**

Homework must be completed in pencil.

Maths- To complete number bonds to 20- finding pairs of numbers that total 20.

Literacy- To find the adjectives in the sentences and re-write your own sentences.

Topic- Follow the instructions on the sheet giving compass directions and mark where you would be for each step.

Please try and read with your child at least 3 times a week and record it in their reading record to support them in moving up through the stages.
