Literacy

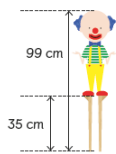
This week the children will be learning about how to change a root word e.g. play using a suffix to change its meaning e.g. played, playing, etc.

The children will be getting their new spellings on Monday to learn at home and will be tested on Friday.

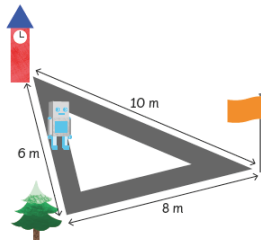
Maths

How far does it travel?

This week in maths children will be solving word problems linked to measuring. They will look for key information in the problems and write a calculation to solve them.

Topic
