Leopards Learning Diary


Week beginning: 21.1.19

Literacy

This week the children will continue their learning about diary entries through a story and showing understanding of events in the story. They will order the story, answer inference questions about it and continue to explore words because, when, if and that to join two sentences together and use what they have learnt this half term to write their diary independently.

Maths

This week in Maths children will be learning about temperature. Children will learn how to read a thermometer accurately and estimate whether a temperature makes the day warm or cold. Children will also be learning about how to solve missing number problems.



Topic

In Geography this week children will be ordering events from Shackleton's expedition on a timeline and writing what they have learnt about him. We will also be practising our class assembly. Please support your child in helping them learn their lines.

P.E

In P.E this week children will continue exploring moving at different levels and creating different movements to use in a winter dance with a partner.
