Literacy

This week is assessment week where the children will complete a variety of tasks on spelling, grammar and punctuation, including their understanding of suffixes, homophones and different sentence types. They will also complete a piece of independent writing to show what they have learnt. The children won't be sent home any spellings this week but will be tested on their year 2 words.

Maths

This week in Maths children will be completing arithmetic and reasoning practice SATs paper's as well as some assessment tasks on what they have learnt this half term- reading scales on a scales, fractions and multiplication and division.

Topic

In D.T this week the children will use their chosen materials for making a strong boat that can float. They will test it and evaluate what went well and what they could do to improve it next time.

P.E

In P.E this week children will be using what they have learnt this half term to put together a dance to perform with a partner.
