**Week Beginning: 15<sup>th</sup> Oct 2018**

English – This week is Spag week in class.

This week the children will look at different punctuation, grammar and sentence structures. During the week the children will recap over capital letters, full stops and exclamation marks. They will also be looking at subordinate and co-ordinate conjunctions along with expanded noun phrases. Spellings this week are focused on suffix words. Spelling test will be on Friday.

Maths – During this week in maths the children will be assessed on all they have learnt throughout the last six weeks of year 3. We will assess their understanding of place value, comparing numbers and addition and subtraction with and without renaming. The children will also be assessed on their times tables. The times tables test will consist of 2,3,4,5,8 and 10.

Topic - This week in History the children will research in more detail of the way of live during this Era and how they hunted for food and compare their lives to the Stone Age.

INFORMATION

All children must read at home at least three times a week with an adult. The adult must also date, comment and sign the child's record book. Don't forget to ask your child questions about the book which also develops their understanding of the text further. *Happy reading!*
