Year 3 Learning Journey

Week Beginning: 10th Sept 2018

English – This week we will be learning about Newspaper reports.

The children have been learning and identifying the key features of a newspaper. This week the children will be looking at newspaper reports in more detail as they set to plan and write their own report based on the Stone Age. The children will also have a book linked to their topic to develop their understanding of the topic. This book is "Ug boy genius of the Stone Age. The children will use this book to give them a foundation to their learning.

Spellings this week are focused on number words. Spelling test will be on Friday.

Maths – The children are learning about Place value from our new maths programme. The children have been using the base 10 to help them identify amounts and ordering and comparing numbers. They will also be counting in fifties, practising times tables and recognising number patterns. The children will also have a times table test every Friday. This week's test will consist of 2,3,5 and 10 as revision.

Topic - During this term the children will be learning about the Stone age – the Iron Age. We will be linking our topic into most of our subjects to make learning more fun and to stimulate minds. History will be taught for the first half term and the second half of the term will be Geography.

This week in History the children will be learning about timelines and when the Stone Age began. Throughout the topic, the children will research the different Age's and will learn about the way of live, tools, hunting for food and compare their lives to the Stone Age.

INFORMATION

All children must read at home at least three times a week with an adult. The adult must also date, comment and sign the child's record book. Don't forget to ask your child questions about the book which also develops their understanding of the text further. *Happy reading!*
