English – This week is instruction week in class.

This week the children will perform as a group of “how to wash a woolly mammoth.” With this the children will at the end of the week the children will write their own set of instructions of how to wash a woolly mammoth.

Spellings this week are focused on suffix words. Spelling test will be on Friday.

Maths – During this week in maths the children will be continuing their learning with subtraction. The children will look at written methods and word problems. The children will also be assessed on their times tables. The times tables test focus is 4.

Topic - This week in Geography the children will be looking at the different types of settlements and how did early settlers choose a site for their settlement.

INFORMATION
