Year 3 Learning Journey

Week Beginning: 14th January 2019

English – This week the children will be focussing on myths and legends and their extended writing on Friday will be to write the middle and end of a given myth. The children will be exposed to various Roman myths in class. They will identify the features and comprehend them. The children will identify some myths have connections and similarities.

At the end of the week the children will have a general spelling test on year 3/4 words.

Maths – During this week in maths the children will continue with multiplication and division. During this chapter the children will learn 2 different methods of multiplying 2 digit numbers by a 1 digit number and a 3 digit number by a 2 digit number e.g. $24 \times 8 =$ and 234

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The children will be looking more at division this week and the different methods they can use. This work will also be part of their homework this week.

The children will do daily times tables tests for 2,3,4,5,8,10,11. It is very important that children are practicing their times tables at home as it is a big part of their maths work in class.

Topic - Our topic this term is The Romans.

Our school trip to the Verulamium Museum will take place on 25th January 2019.

This week the children will be identifying the Gods and Goddesses and what each of they stood for. They will also be learning about what the Romans beliefs were.

INFORMATION

All children must read at home at least three times a week with an adult. The adult must also date, comment and sign the child's record book. Don't forget to ask your child questions about the book which also develops their understanding of the text further.

Every Thursday the children will bring home a library book and an activity book. This book **MUST** be returned the following Thursday to allow the children to change them.
