Week Beginning: 11th March 2019

English – This week the children will be looking at instructions over the two weeks. We will be identifying the key features and annotating various instructions. The children will also be making Roman bread and writing out a setoff instructions to match the recipe.

At the minute the children are really enjoying their class viper book, “The Iron man”. We are moving onto chapter 3 and 4 this week. We will be focusing on inference and prediction questioning based on these chapters.

At the end of the week the children will have a general spelling test on words that are spelt with the suffix _ous and year 3 /4 national curriculum spellings

Maths – During this week in maths the children will be finishing off the maths no problem workbook with end of book assessments. Afterwards they will be starting their second book.

This work will also be part of their homework this week.

The children will do daily times tables tests for 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,10,11. It is very important that children are practicing their times tables at home as it is a big part of their maths work in class.

This week’s times table focus is 9 times tables.

To develop your child’s times-tables, there are many different websites they can play on. Topmarks is a very good website and can also broaden their understanding of maths.

Topic - Our topic this term is The Romans. We will be looking at the Geography aspect of the Romans.

This week the children will learn the skill of looking up an atlas and locating the hills and mountains around the UK.

INFORMATION

All children must read at home at least three times a week with an adult. The adult must also date, comment and sign the child’s record book. Don’t forget to ask your child questions about the book which also develops their understanding of the text further.

Every Thursday the children will bring home a library book and an activity book. This book **MUST** be returned the following Thursday to allow the children to change them.
