LITERACY

In our English sessions this week the children will be focusing on writing newspaper articles. Last week continued working on our diary writing skills and made huge progress writing diaries for Miss Stocker. At the end of the week, we wrote another diary from the perspective of a character in our class book, the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe. The children produced some brilliant work.

Our newspaper articles will focus on some key events in the story that we have just read. The first will be about the disappearance of Mr Tumnus and the second about the killing of Aslan by the White Witch. This unit will take us up to the half term break and will also provide them with the opportunity to create some great work.

NUMERACY

SCIENCE
