LITERACY

In our English sessions this week the children will continue focusing on writing balanced arguments and will be holding debates in the classroom. The two debates that we will hold are:

- Which is better, Summer or Winter?
and
- Will robots soon take over the world?

For both of these debates, the children will need to consider two sides of an argument and use their knowledge of both sides to make their final decisions.

In our grammar work we will be looking in depth how to use and identify pronouns.

NUMERACY

Our numeracy this week will focus on adding and subtracting fractions which have different denominators. This is a tricky skill for children and one that you can learn more about online by visiting YouTube and searching for **maths antics – Common Denominator ECD**

SCIENCE
