Literacy

In Literacy this week, we will be producing an independent piece of writing to 'show off' our skills in character and setting description. We will also learn the features of short stories. SPaG will be taught and practised throughout the week.

Maths

In Maths this week, we will be focussing on converting measures of length, weight and capacity. We will also be calculating the area and perimeter of regular and compound shapes. Timestables will be tested throughout the week.

Science

In Science, we will be continuing our Electricity unit and learn about what a switch does, and how different types of switches can control different circuits.

Topic
