Literacy

In Literacy this we will introduce our new writing theme, focussing on diary entries. We will learn the features of a diary, understand their purpose and identify the use of multiple tenses. Our SPaG focus will be on using possessive apostrophes for plural nouns and verb tense changes.

Maths

In maths we will continue to look at measures focussing on weight (mass) and capacity. We will understand how each unit of measure is converted and complete problem solving (reasoning) activities.

Timestables will be tested throughout the week.

Science

Within our unit on electricity, we will move on to use our existing knowledge of circuits, to create our own pressure switches, using everyday materials.

Topic

We will be exploring the nature of crime and punishment throughout the medieval times. We will make comparisons to the Roman justice system, identifying any differences and make comment as to whether the punishment fit the crime!
