**Literacy**

In Literacy this week, we will be working towards writing our crime reports based on the recreated 'break-in' in the Year 6 classroom at Thornhill Primary. We will write interview transcripts, compile our own summaries of what we think actually happened and finish with a formal police report.

**Spellings** will be tested throughout the week.

**Maths**

In maths we will continue our work with angles in relation to shapes. We will explore the angles in triangles and quadrilaterals, ensuring that we also know the properties of these types of shapes. All new learning will be applied to problem solving and reasoning activities. **Timestables** will be tested throughout the week.

**Science**

In Science, we will complete our unit on electricity, by having a debate on which methods are the most efficient in generating electricity, as well as complete an assessment to find out how much we have learned.

**Topic**
