#### **Literacy**

In Literacy this week, we will be completing our crime reports! In continuation of our Crime and Punishment theme, we will move on to start thinking about persuasive texts. We will look at the features, decide what makes them effective and ask questions like – ‘Should we have CCTV in schools? Should we use mobile phones in schools?’ **Spellings** will be tested throughout the week.

#### **Maths**

In maths we will be learning strategies to plot co-ordinates on a single axis and on all four quadrants. We will also learn how to construct shapes on an axis and identify missing points. All new learning will be applied to problem solving and reasoning activities. **Timestables** will be tested throughout the week.

#### **Science**

In Science, we will complete our unit on electricity, by having a debate on which methods are the most efficient in generating electricity, as well as complete an assessment to find out how much we have learned.

#### **Topic**
