

Personal, Social and Emotional development

We will continue to follow our nursery rules.

We will talk about our goals for the future and review our learning so far in Nursery.

We will practice taking turns by playing simple board games as well as games outside in groups.

We will be taking turns in daily circle time sessions and listening to our friends speak.

We will be learning about different types of emotions and how we can make each other feel better.

We learn about how to look after different types of animals, including: pets, farm, wild and endangered animals.

Understanding of the World

We will become familiar with the names of animals and their babies.

We will learn to match animals and their babies

We will learn about the homes of different animals

We will look at different occupations, thinking about people who work with animals; farmer, zoo keeper, pet owners etc

We will be learning how to control and operate the beebots, reinforcing positional language.

We explore seasonal changes

We will be planting and growing flowers and plants.

We will learn to how to care for living things.

Communication and Language and Literacy

We will be listening to stories about animals and retelling them in our own words.

We will be leaning our sounds with daily Jolly Phonics sessions

We will be learning to write our names, form letters correctly and write the initial sounds in words, for example making labels for small world animals

We will be learning vocabulary linked to the features of different animals.

We will be making our own books, posters, labels, tags and letters and learning about how print conveys meaning.

Physical development

We will be developing our fine motor skills, through daily activities these will include: scissor skills, puzzles, threading, using the dough and tools.

We will be developing our gross motor (larger movements) through daily use of outdoor learning spaces, bike riding, throwing, catching and kicking hoops and large balls.

We will be exploring how different animals move and how we can move like they do.

We will be learning about healthy eating and exercise and why it's important.

Mathematics

We will be sorting animals based on their sized and developing our comparative language linked to size.

We will be measuring different animals using non standard forms of measurement

We will be developing our counting skills and number recognition through number of the week.

We will be learning to count and compare different groups of animals.

We will be learning how to record numbers through use of tallys, charts and pictograms.

Expressive arts and design

We will be developing imaginative role play through different small world environments

We will be learning how create animals through the use of dough, paint, construction, junk modelling and collage materials.

We will be learning how to create and repeat simple rhythms, exploring how sounds can be changed.

We will be doing observational painting of different types of animals
