Leopards Learning Diary


Week beginning: 6.4.19

Literacy

This week the children will be completing some writing tasks using a variety of the things they have learnt this year including year 2 words spelt correctly, using past and present tense, using correct punctuation and using conjunctions or, but, and. They will be writing about Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and comparing the characters Charlie Bucket and Matilda using expanded noun phrases. Children will also be completing some reading comprehension challenges to prepare them further for their SAT's. The children will be bringing home spellings this week.

Maths

This week in Maths children will be learning about time. They will recap on how to tell the time, looking at the features of an analogue clock, in o' clock, half past and quarter to and past. Children will then move on to telling the time in 5 minute intervals and how to read times on a digital clock. Children will also practice SATs questions on these.



Topic

In Art this week children will be completing their first draft of an observational drawing of a butterfly. Children will be trying as much as possible to draw the image as close to the real thing as possible. They will then share their work with a partner and share ideas in how they can improve their drawing skills when they come to draw it again next week.

P.E

In P.E this week we will be practicing running in preparation for Sports Day. Children will learn about posture, balance and speed to help them.
