Literacy

This week the children will be going over some of the things they have learnt this year in preparation for their SATs SPaG test this week. They will complete some writing using conjunctions 'and', 'or' and 'but' as well as using words such as 'because', 'if' and 'when' to join sentences together. Children will also write a newspaper article based on the story Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl.

The children will be bringing home spellings this week.

Maths

This week in Maths children will be continuing their learning about time. They will look at how we use time to order events in the day e.g. going to school, lunchtime, dinner time, bed time. Children will learn about how many minutes there are in an hour, how many hours are in a day and how many days there are in a week/month, etc.

On Friday the children will be completing their Maths Reasoning SAT's paper.
