ASSESSMENT WEEK

Literacy

Over the course of the week, children will complete assessment tests where they will have opportunities to work independently to showcase their learning this half term. Children will be assessed on spelling, grammar, punctuation and writing.

We will also work on reading comprehension assessments to inform future planning.

Maths

Children will be assessed in their arithmetic and reasoning skills. The children will have two papers to sit during the week. These tests will cover the topics they have learnt this half term but will also touch on previous learning to assess learning. Adding, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and word problems will be assessed.

Topic

As we come to the end of the units in Geography, Science and DT, children will engage in assessment activities which allow opportunity for them to evidence their learning over this half term. Outcomes of these activities will be used to inform judgements on their attainment in these curriculum areas.
