Week Beginning: 25th March 2019

English – This week the children will be looking at instructions over the two weeks. We are identifying the key features and annotating various instructions. The children will be planning a set of instructions on how to be a roman gladiator. During this week we will be preforming and discussing suitable instructions. At the minute the children are really enjoying their class viper book, “The Iron man”. We have moved onto the final chapter, chapter 5 this week. We will be focusing on vocabulary, inference and prediction questioning based on these chapters. At the end of the week the children will have a general spelling test on prefixes and year 3 /4 national curriculum spellings

Maths – During this week in maths the children are learning about money. We are adding pounds and pence with and without renaming. The children will also be having hands on practical experience with money to aid them in their learning. The children will do daily times tables tests for 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,10,11 and 12. It is very important that children are practicing their times tables at home as it is a big part of their maths work in class. This week’s times table focus is 11 times tables. To develop your child’s times-tables, there are many different websites they can play on. Topmarks is a very good website and can also broaden their understanding of maths.

Topic - Our topic this term is The Romans. We will be looking at the Geography aspect of the Romans. This week the children will learn how the Roman Empire had an impact on Britain.

INFORMATION

All children must read at home at least three times a week with an adult. The adult must also date, comment and sign the child’s record book. Don’t forget to ask your child questions about the book which also develops their understanding of the text further.

Every Thursday the children will bring home a library book and an activity book. This book **MUST** be returned the following Thursday to allow the children to change them.
