Literacy

In Literacy this week, we will be aiming to complete our final independent piece of writing on our balanced argument. The children will be addressing the question 'Should we have CCTV placed in our schools?' They will be guided through the writing process by drafting, editing and rewriting their final pieces. **Spellings** will be tested throughout the week.

Maths In maths, we will be learning about the features of 3d shapes and completing associated problem solving activities. We will also be learning how to find the area of parallelograms and triangles – understanding that there are formulas/rules and strategies to solving these shape problems. We will hope to carry out an assessment involving shapes. All new learning will be applied to problem solving and reasoning activities. **Timestables** will be tested throughout the week.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at the advantages and disadvantages of 'Selective Breeding'. We will work in groups to discuss this and hold a debate to put forward our views. We will understand that selective breeding can occur in both animals and plants.

Topic

We will be taking a brief look at the concept of 'capital punishment' and discover how this has evolved over time and the procedures that take place for each. We will understand that many forms of capital punishment still exist in the world today and therefore have a discussion as to whether this 'type of punishment' should be a way to deal with crime.
