Literacy

In Literacy, we will take some time to reflect on life in year 6 so far and produce a short piece of writing to record this. We will also revisit 'Streetchild' by Berlie Doherty, which is all about a young boy called Jim and is set in the Victorian times. Our task will be to write a letter to Shrimps, outlining some of the experiences Jim has had so far, but also to express how he feels about his friend, and the plans they could make together once they are reunited.

Maths

In Maths, we will be embarking on a new Theme Park Project which will incorporate many mathematical skills and concepts. This week, we will work in groups to brainstorm ideas as to what 'theme' the park will be and begin to think about any features we would like to include, e.g. main attractions etc.

Topic
