Literacy

In Literacy, we will be planning to rewrite the thought-provoking story of the 'Replay' animation courtesy of Literacy Shed. The story is set in a futuristic, apocalyptic world impoverished by men, where oxygen is scarce and humans must live underground. Our task will be to retell the story in a creative and interesting way which entices the reader.

We will also be writing character descriptions based on a choice of 3 characters from the animation 'Broken'. Again, we will be applying the principles of Austin's Butterfly – completing many drafts towards perfection. We will be considering a characters' appearance, behaviour and overall personality to help us to produce quality pieces of writing.

Maths

In Maths this week, our new Theme Park Project will require us to think more about how our money is spent and confirming how much we would earn in a month and a year. We will also think about advertising and branding and discuss the importance of producing a logo which is eye-catching, memorable and fitting with the 'theme' of our park.

Topic

We will look at placing England and Poland on a map of the world to make links with some of our allies in World War 2, but also to recognise the polish codebreakers who helped Turing to make his own developments when breaking the German 'codes'. In addition, we will identify all of the major allies and axis powers on a map to see how the 'World War' consisted of many countries across the globe.
