Maths

In Maths this week, we will be using everything we can get our hands on to produce a visual representation of our theme park. We will work from a blue print drawing/design and aim to use our knowledge of scale to produce a bigger version. We will be creating and using nets to provide a '3d' element to our park as well as other physical resources we can get hold of!

Topic

In Topic, we will fast forward to modern times by investigating modern codes and coding. We will research the types of coding available and those that are in development. We will look at: credit card codes, barcodes, isbn codes, qr codes and many more.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the Sikh tradition of the langar. We will describe what the langar is and find out how it began. We will learn how a free meal served to the community, from a Sikh community kitchen, tells us a lot about Sikh beliefs.
