Week beginning Monday 9th September 2019 – Continental Week

This week we will be focusing on the continent of Asia

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will be practising getting ourselves undressed and dressed for PE.
- We will be focusing on this terms school value “Confidence”
- We will be ensuring we follow the rules of basic hygiene, remembering to wash our hands after the toilet and before we eat.
- We will be joining in with different activities and developing our skills to take turns.
- We will be learning and following class rules and routine.

Physical Development

- We will be developing our fine motor skills through the use of tweezers, threading, cutting etc. This will help to develop our pencil grip.
- We will be using larger equipment such as balls, bikes and hoops to develop our gross motor.
- In PE we will be practicing our balancing skills.

Communication and Language

- We will be practising following instructions given by classroom adults.
- Using the Easi phones we will be practising making and receiving calls.
- We will be encouraged to talk aloud in small groups about our own interests.
- **Literacy**
- We will be hearing and identifying the first sound in words.
- We will be practising our letter formation through daily practise of writing our names as well as daily handwriting practise.
- **Maths**
- We will be counting objects to 5 then 10.
- We will be matching quantity to numeral. For example matching 4 objects to the number 4.
- We will be creating rangoli patterns using coloured pasta.
- **Understanding the world**
- Using our 2simple art program, we will create our own pictures.
- We will be inputting directions into our class Beebot to make it move.
- We will be talking about different countries in Asia such as China, Japan and India and comparing them to our own cultures and community.
- **Expressive Arts and Design**
- We will be creating our own collage elephants using a range of colours.
- We will be using recycled materials to create objects.
