

1. WHERE IN THE WORLD IS YOUR ISLAND?

Which sea or ocean does your island lay in? Is it in the Northern or Southern hemisphere?

Which countries and/or other islands are closest to it? How close? Which continent can claim it? What are the co-ordinates of your island? **Use an atlas/interactive globe etc.**

TASK -Design and label a map of your island. Name it too.

2. DESCRIBE YOUR ISLAND – FIRST IMPRESSIONS

How did you feel when you first found your island? What did you see, smell, sense etc?

TASK - Using all of your senses, write a description of your island (in the first person). (2-3 paragraphs)

Think about descriptive words, phrases and sentences which stimulate the readers' senses.

Example: A whisper of a gentle breeze and the splash of the sea...

3. CREATE A NATIONAL IDENTITY

TASK -Design a national flag. What shapes or symbols will you use? What colours will make up its design? What will it mean to the people?

Yellow (sun)

Blue (sign of hope)

TASK - Design a national anthem - A symbolic, patriotic song. What lyrics will you choose? What will they mean to the people in your country? How will it sound?

TASK – What does your country stand for? What are its principles?
